- Gallery installation Sunday, September 29, 2019
- Bring/serve refreshments for reception on Friday, October 4, 2019
- Showing the raffle quilt at guilds and quilt shops to help advertise the show and sell a few raffle tickets. (July – September)
- Docents/hand quilters for the “Met the Maker” in the gallery during lunchtime for Innovations for Textiles on Saturday, October 5, 2019
- Take bookmarks to a quilt shop (July – September)
- Tear down the exhibit on Friday, November 1, 2019

## CSQ Council Meeting, May 14, 2019

Supper meeting was held at the home of Laura Falk.

Attendees: Gwen Clopton, Laura Falk, Betsy Sweeney, Kim Donermeyer, Terry Friedman, Deborah Carnes

Reports were given:

- Membership – Deborah reported that 37 members have renewed their membership. Rosters will be mailed after the end of May.
- Treasurer – Betsy reported the bank balance is \$4,119.02.
- Charity Quilts – 30 quilts have been donated to date. A handwritten thank you note has been received for our donations. Pat Owoc has a pattern that could potentially be used to make kits.
- Quilt Show –
  - A handout regarding the quilt show will be handed out at the May guild meeting. Prizes and size categories were discussed.
  - Terry Friedman volunteered to solicit donations for prizes. Laura Falk will contact upcoming speaker Ann Hazelwood to ask her to bring her books during the show. Gwen Clopton will make a sleeve for the quilt and get a photo made as well as getting raffle tickets printed.
  - A list of quilt shops and guilds were handed out to see who if anyone needs to be added. The list will be shown at the May meeting for members to sign up to attend and present the raffle quilt.
  - A press release will be sent to newspapers and quilt shops.
  - Bookmarks for the raffle will be printed in blue paper to match the quilt color.
  - Photographing of the entries was discussed. It was suggested that the August meeting would be a good opportunity if everyone's quilts would be ready.
  - Jeanne Wilton has agreed to have her quilt used for the gallery cards at the library.
